



The Provinces of Groningen and Drenthe as well as the Groningen-Drenthe Public Transportation Agency strive to offer all passengers a pleasant journey – whatever means of transportation you prefer or wherever you are heading.

Our hubs offer many services which will make your journey as comfortable as possible, such as free Wi-Fi, public water taps and safe bicycle storage in bicycle lockers. Yet a hub is so much more, as it – potentially – can even become a key public area in a region. Indeed, it is in fact the very place to cluster all kinds of general public services.

In Roden for instance, a collaboration was set up with a local public library and in Gieten en Zuidhorn with a kiosk. Likewise in Sibbeuren, a church annex behind the hub is being developed into a multifunctional centre (MFC). It is designated to harbour a library, a general practice and a pharmacy.

In developing our hubs, ample space is provided for (local) initiatives. In this context, our Hub Project Group would very much like to get in touch with regional inhabitants, care institutions, entrepreneurs, municipalities, landowners and transport companies, thus allowing each hub to develop its own specific local character.


